RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

My work follows a behavioral approach and generally focuses on the role of IT/IS and digitization in creation of value at all levels. Most of my emphasis has been on IS value, IS strategy, e-business, KM, reengineering, and innovation. More recently, my work focuses on the concept of digital/AI (ontologically) and its effects on the individual (identity, stress) and the organization (transformation, culture). I also take an interest in introspective work on the IS field and its welfare. While my work employs a positivist epistemology, it is not locked into one philosophy or even methodology. I have conducted field surveys, experimental designs, structured interviews, content analysis, secondary data analyses (e.g., strategic group analysis, event studies), field experiments, and modeling. Most of my work has been published in major refereed journals, and I co-edited three books on IT and process change. I have been fortunate enough to have received a number of research awards and have been consistently recognized as the 1st, 2nd, or 3rd most productive researcher in widely recognized major (A level) IS journals (e.g., *MIS Quarterly*, *Journal of MIS*, *Information Systems Research*) in ten independent published studies and the 2nd most influential researcher based on citation impact in a recent study. Since 1990-today, I am the 2nd most published researcher in the prestigious AIS “Basket of 6” journals. I have also served in prominent roles at national conferences (e.g., ICIS, DSI, AIS) and have been (and am) involved in leadership roles (e.g., Senior Editorship) in numerous premier journals.

TEACHING ACTIVITIES

I have taught a variety of IS courses, although my major areas of teaching have been in the core IS management course, the telecommunications course at the Master's level and PhD research seminars. At the Katz School of Business, University of Pittsburgh, I was the only doctoral student to be hired as a lecturer teaching 2 MBA courses/semester. Over 12 years at the Moore School of Business (MSB), I was consistently evaluated at the highest level in the college and was fortunate enough to receive a number of teaching awards from both students and faculty (including two-time receipt of the college-wide Alfred G. Smith Award for Teaching Excellence and two-time Outstanding MBA Professor Award). At MSB I spent significant time directing the curriculum, procedures, and standards for all IS programs. My particular interest at USC was toward creating a top notch PhD program in IS, which we successfully accomplished as reflected in the placement quality. At Clemson, I have been involved in program and curriculum development at the undergraduate, graduate and PhD levels. The doctoral program is successful based on the quality of students and the intensive standards for doctoral requirements, student success in consortia (like ICIS), student publications (ranked as #1 among 700 institutions in a CAIS article) and student placements. My teaching at Clemson has focused exclusively on graduate courses, including the core MBA (MSIM) and PhD course in IS, as well as research seminars in classical IS research, theory and research methods. I have received the Outstanding Graduate Teaching Award twice at Clemson. Now, at the Walton College of Business, I have taught a PhD seminar and a large MBA class, both with the highest evaluations (close to 5/5). My teaching evaluations for all courses across my career have consistently been high across the board (generally between 4.7 and 5 of a 5-point scale), complemented with very positive comments, and well above department and college averages.
